Merry Christmas and Happy New Year to you and your family from the Board of Trustees!

Many of you have been asking about the letter we sent regarding our new internal Line of Credit progam. First, we want to thank Members who stepped forward. We are happy to report that we reached the maximum amount we were looking to borrow.

I think the majority of our members understand that we operate a very seasonal business. During the winter off-season months, our Clubhouse generates very little income. Most seasonal businesses "bridge" the slow times with an operating line-of-credit, and in discussing our financial needs for the winter we thought it made more sense to borrow from (and give the interest to) Members instead of the bank.

The Board views short-term winter financing as a "necessary evil" for the next three years. This internal Lineof-Credit program allows us to benefit Members while we also meet our obligations. Looking forward, we can all expect the golf course to move toward profitability over the next four years as our lease-to-purchase agreements on turf equipment and our golf cart fleet reach payoff.
