Just to give you an idea how ENF helps our lodge, over the last three years we have invested nearly \$5700 in ENF and received \$12,000 back from ENF as grants for youth and veteran's activities.

## Notes From the Secretary by Butch Lyons

Please do your part as an Elk, and make sure your dues have been paid this year. Your 2013-14 dues were due April 1 2013. We still have over 30 unpaid dues. Unpaid dues are always frustrating for the Lodge.

First we see an out-of-pocket loss when we are required to send nearly \$20 to Grand Lodge in the Spring for each active member. If you receive a dues notice, you are on our roster and we have no choice but to pay Grand Lodge - even if you don't pay us. We have not only lost your \$90.50 from our budget, we have also spent another \$20 in paying your fee to Grand Lodge. It's a net loss of \$110 for each delinquent member.

Then, every time we have to send out dues notices, it takes money away from other projects to pay for printing and postage. So please, if you have not paid, do so now. Your membership in the Elks, and your dues support of the Lodge is critical to our continued existence!
