#### Hastings Elks Lodge By-Laws Revision

Grand Lodge requires that all Elks Lodge By-Laws be revisited every 5 years. Hastings Elks Lodge PER's held a work day on Sunday, December 17 to discuss our by-laws. The following are the revisions of our Bylaws prepared by our PER's. If anyone has any revision or additions to the following revisions, please submit your proposal in writing during our February 13, 2018 Lodge meeting or to any officer of the lodge. If there is no objections, additions or revision voting will take place during our lodge meeting on February 13. If there is any objections, additions or revision the By-Law vote will be tabled. An April 1, 2018 deadline has been given for the By-Laws to be passed by the lodge.

PROPOSED BY-LAW REVISIONS

Page 3 ARTICLE IV; Section 2 meeting time shall be 7:00 pm **add** when daylight saving time is in effect the meeting time shall be 8:00pm.

Page 3 ARTICLE V; Section 1 –five trustees etc. **add** at least one of the Trustees must be a PER **add** All Lodge Officers are required to be an "active Member "of one Lodge Committee and one House Committee.

CHANGE

Page 10 ARTICLE IX:; Section 1: The operation, management and control of the Home, Club or other facility owned and/or occupied by this Lodge shall be supervised and conducted by :The Exalted Ruler, Esteemed Leading Knight, Esteemed Loyal Knight, Esteemed Lecturing Knight, and the Trustees of the Lodge; The supervising or managing body of the Home, Club or other facility provided for herein, shall be subject to the control and direction of the Lodge, except those actions and decisions pertaining to an employment relationship and the fixing of prices for goods and services.

Page 10 ARTICLE X; Section 1-(initiation fees- no change \$25 for over 26 years-\$10 21 to 25 years) **add** The Lodge shall have a reduced initiation fee of one dollar (\$1:00) for the months of April and September.

Page 11 ARTICLE X; Section 2-part c: Life Membership — THE REQUIREMENT THAT LIFE DUES MUST BE AT LEAST HALF OF REGULAR DUES MUST BE ENFORCED - LIFE DUES WILL BE \$36.00—there is no vote on this requirement

Page 11 ARTICLE X; Section 2-part d: Lodge to **add** ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP- each Associate Membership shall pay an annual fee in the amount of \$25.00 in advance.

Page 11 ARTICLE X; Section 3 **add** Reinstatement fee for Absolute Dimit \$25.00: Transfer Dimit \$15.00: Certificate of Release \$25.00

Page 11 ARTICLE X; Section 4 **add** The Lodge has <u>not</u> adopted a \$1:00 reduced reinstatement fee

Page 12 ARTICLE XIII; Section 2 **add** The Treasurer may pay recurring bills upon the approval of the Board of Trustees (or Board of Directors as may be applicable) without obtaining prior Lodge approval. Any such payment shall be reported at the next Lodge meeting.

Page 12 ARTICLE XIII; Section 3 **add** The Treasurer may designate a specific member of the Board of Trustees (or Board of Directors as may be applicable), or chair officer, subject to Lodge approval, to sign Lodge checks in the Treasurer's absence. Any such designee shall be bonded in the same amount as the Treasurer.

#### Reaffirm

Page 13 ARTICLE XV-A The Lodge hereby recognizes DOES DROVE 112 as the official Ladies Auxiliary (Auxiliaries) of the Lodge provided its (their) aims and purposes remain consistent with those of the Lodge and the Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks.

#### Page 17 HOUSE RULES

# HASTINGS ELKS LODGE 159 HOUSE RULES AND REGULATIONS

Adopted by the Lodge 1991 Revised and Reapproved 1994,1999,2002,2008, 2013, 2017

- The House Committee shall have full charge of: Club Activities; The Building; The By-Laws of the Club and these Rules.
- It is the duty of the House Committee to enforce all Club Rules and to maintain proper conduct of all members in the club and course grounds. They will be responsible for the business operations of the Club.
- 3) No intoxication liquor of any kind shall be brought on to the property or carried from the property. No intoxicated person shall be served intoxicating beverages.

#### MANAGEMENT HAS THE RIGHT TO REFUSE SERVICE TO ANYONE.

- 4) Candidates who have been duly elected to membership in the Order. May be extended the privileges of the Club prior to initiation for such time as may be reasonable and proper.
- 5) The use of profane or vulgar language in the building or on the grounds is prohibited.
- 6) Members are allowed to bring guests for any social function, Members bringing a guest will be held responsible for their conduct, and the guest/guests must remain in the company of the member at all times.
- 7) A CARD KEY will be provided by the secretary to all members in good standing. It is <u>MANDATORY</u> that these card keys be used to gain admission to the building. No member shall be allowed privileges of the building whose dues are more than thirty days past due.
- 8) The building will be open as deemed necessary by the House Committee.
- 9) The bar in the Club House shall be closed during regular sessions of the Lodge.
- 10) At no time during special youth events, will drinks be permitted in the area where youths are present.
- 11) Under no circumstance shall credit be extended by the club to any member or guest. Checks will not be held under any circumstance.
- 12) Property of this Lodge defaced or injured must be paid for by the member responsible.
- 13) Any suggestions or criticism regarding the operation of the Club/ Golf Course shall be submitted in writing to the House Committee. The same will be given due consideration. Members are requested to report to the House Committee any inattention of duty on the part of employees. No member other than management shall at any time reprimand an employee of the club.
- 14) The violation of any Club Rule as adopted, or any conduct unbecoming an Elk may be cause for suspension or revocation of any or all Club privileges of the offending member pursuant to Grand Lodge Statute Section 16.040.
