He and his wife Erika made a delicious Macaroni salad and brought it with a printed recipe for every teen that joined us. It is

difficult to make and eat a pasta salad at the same class because the salad needs to marinate for more than 2 hrs. for the best taste, however, Aaron has laying chickens, so he donated a dozen fresh boiled eggs to add to the salad. He then taught the kids all of the tricks to properly peel the shells off. Most there had never done that, so they were happy to try it and get the confidence that they can do that

for themselves and expand what they can fix at meal time. Very simple lessons and tips go along way and are so appreciated. While some were peeling eggs, others peeled and cut cucumbers and onions, and made an oil and vinegar dressing.

For dessert we made a simple cheese cake that set in the fridge while we went outside to learn some tips from master griller Martinez. He actually competes in cook offs on the grill so we all learned great tips. He made delicious pork chops and chicken that was marinated a couple of hours in advance. The kids all received a sheet with recipes of everything we made as well as other summertime recipes they can use. The kids absolutely loved him, and they felt as if he was easy to relate too. On April 28th Boy Scouts from Kearney, Hastings along with Dick Freeling worked to remove old benches, decking and began redecking of the stage.










